RE: **SECOND CALL FOR PROJECTS: FY 2013**

As a result of FAC projects receiving stimulus funding, a significant amount of regular STP dollars have become available to the FAC. The Oakland FAC Funding Committee met on March 10, 2009 in order to backfill the project lists with approved projects. However, there were not enough approved projects in the TIP to consume all available additional funds, and there is now \$12,135,000 available in regular STP funds for FY2013.

Thus, the Funding Committee has issued a second call for projects. Projects submitted will be funded in FY2013 and must be on federal aid eligible roads. The committee will consider 3R, 4R, and Next Phase projects.

The next Oakland County Federal Aid Funding Committee meeting will be May 19, 2009. Submitted projects will compete for available federal funding and be approved at that time.

Please download the latest application forms and instructions from the website at www.oaklandfac.org. There is no form for Next Phase projects. Please submit a letter describing the project, the next phase requested, and an updated PACE form.

Note: New forms are not required for project packets that have already been submitted for FY2013 and did not receive funding -- if those submissions contain no changes. Please forward a letter indicating the name of the project, the limits, and verification that there are no changes from the previous submission.

Additional Materials Required for All New Projects

1. Cover Sheet with the Following Information:

- A. Jurisdiction
- B. Location and Limits of Project
- C. Length of Segment
- D. Proposed Improvement and Phase of Development (CON)
- E. Total Estimated Cost:
 - 1. Federal: Source (STPU)
 - 2. Non-Federal: Source (MTF, General Fund, etc.)
- F. Anticipated Obligation Date

2. Completed STPU Rating Sheets (as appropriate), and the appropriate Project Activities Cost Estimates (PACE) form. Please submit a separate PACE form for each project along with project rating sheets.

3. Planning Documentation:

A brief paragraph describing the rationale for the project and any other appropriate data and documentation.

All project submissions must be received by Friday, May 8, 2009 to be considered.
