The Oakland County Federal Aid Task Force met on October 13, 2015 and issued a call for projects in the following categories: **Restoration, Resurfacing, Rehabilitation (RRR) as well as Restoration, Resurfacing, Rehabilitation and Reconstruction (4R) projects for FY 2019. Project application submissions are due no later than Friday January 22, 2016 at 4:00 PM.**

Please note that the 3R and 4R Project Activities Cost Estimate (PACE) form is available as a fillable Excel file which will perform calculations automatically. Also, construction activity costs should be generally in line with MDOT's most recent Pay Item Code costs. **Please ensure submissions are completed on the current worksheets by downloading them from our website at [www.oaklandfac.org](http://www.oaklandfac.org) and navigating to "Forms".**

Surface Transportation Program – Urban (STPU) Target  
SEMCOG anticipates the STPU target for FY 2019 to be approximately \$15 million.

Set-Asides  
The Funding Committee sets aside \$2 million in STPU funding each fiscal year for gravel road paving projects on county roads, as well as \$500 thousand for urban to rural transfer.

Due to a revised funding target for FY 2018, the FAC Task Force approved moving \$1,983,950 in 2018 approved projects to FY 2019. This amount, along with the set-asides, will be subtracted from the FY 2019 target. This will result in approximately \$10.5 million being available for new RRR and 4R projects.
