RE: **CALL FOR FEDERAL AID PROJECT FISCAL YEAR 2014**

The Oakland County Federal Aid Task Force met on October 6, 2009 and issued a call for projects in the following categories: **Restoration, Resurfacing, Rehabilitation (RRR), Reconstruction (4R), and Next Phase STPU projects for FY 2014.** A call was not made for Category C or new STPU Widening projects.

The next Oakland County Federal Aid Funding Committee meeting will be held on Tuesday, February 23, 2010 for the purpose of approving submitted projects for federal aid funding. **Project submissions are due no later than Thursday, January 21, 2010.**

Please note that the 3R forms have been revised as approved by the Task Force. The 3R forms are now available as Adobe PDF, are fillable, and will perform calculations automatically. There has been no update to the 4R or PACE forms. Please ensure you submit your projects on the newest forms by visiting our website at www.oaklandfac.org to download the current worksheets.

Surface Transportation Program – Urban (STPU)

The specific STPU targets for FY 2014 are not yet available. However, due to the current downturn in the national and local economy, we expect targets to be near or below the \$17.6 million level estimate for FY2013. **The Task Force has voted to accept only Next Phase project submissions for FY 2014.** For next phase STPU projects please submit an updated Project Activity Cost Estimates (PACE) form.

Pave Gravel

The Funding Committee sets aside \$1.5 million in STPU funding each fiscal year for gravel road paving projects on county roads.

RRR/4R

The Funding Committee generally sets aside a sum of STPU funding each fiscal year for RRR and 4R projects in the urban area. However, this is subject to change by the Funding Committee.

 - 2. Non-Federal: Source (MTF, General Fund, etc.)
- F. Anticipated Obligation Date

2. Completed Project Activities Cost Estimates (PACE) Form. Please note that there is one PACE form for both 3R and 4R projects, and a separate PACE form for both STPU and Category C projects. In addition, ensure that an individual PACE form is included for each project.

3. Planning Documentation:

A brief paragraph describing the rationale for the project and any other appropriate data and documentation.

All project submissions must be received by **Thursday, January 21, 2010** to be considered.
